## “Make Your Mark” Scholarship Contest Renewed for 2009/2010

KANSAS CITY, MO – (September 17, 2009) – **The Lewer Agency, Inc.** announced that it has renewed its “**Make Your Mark**” Scholarship Contest for the fifth consecutive year – the 2009/2010 school year. The popular program rewards international students sponsored by a school enrolled in any of the agency’s LewerMark programs.

Student entrants – both inbound and study abroad students – are challenged to submit a 500-word essay that answers the question: “How will an international education help me make a difference in the world?”

Three scholarships will be awarded to the winners through the sponsoring schools. The first place award is \$1,000.00. The second and third place awards have been increased, as of last year, to \$750.00 and \$500.00 respectively.

The student’s essays must be submitted by March 2, 2010 to the Lewer Agency by the sponsoring schools. The winners must be attending school after the award is granted in order to receive the scholarship proceeds for the next school year.
